I have just time to write a few lines by this Post, to inform you that Mr. Adey has received by the Steamer a small Bale of Slops which I think would just suit you having given up all his now to Mr. Wills he has as further use for them as contains

not told me the price he would require at an advance but should think he will not obtain more than 50/- I believe the bale would come to £40 altogether and as he works for the Slops for his own use he desired they might be of the best description, Mr. Adey told me this morning he proposed going into the Drawing Room to day, he has now been a month in bed, and had a very severe time of it, but this fine weather is very much in his favor, I suppose you have had a mild

winter at Rosedale, to day is quite like Spring weather,
There is a great deal of Town Talk at present about
Mrs Boyd and Colt Logan, Mr Boyd was the
wife of the Deputy Surveyor General & some time
ago she lodged at Mrs Lord when you was in
Town last the Governor believes it and they could
be no longer received at Govt House & the Colt
has gone to New Norfolk. I suppose you have
told you Bullock as I had not heard further
from you, I should very much like to see
you and my mother in Hobartow but you
will not come until the weather is perfect-
ly settled I suppose in October when there
is not much to do, Mr Tracy was here
yesterday, and wanted the money for his auct,
he will allow for the three pairs of Trousers,
not delivered, he has got the mans receipt
and is supposed short of Cash.
