which they broke down the sheep

pens letting the sheep among them  
I must have lost 20 at least by the

cattle trampling on them. The  
sheep were rather so fat they

also would have been better <sup>at home</sup>  
being so hot I got the same over

safe 10 - the deck sheep did best  
persons sending sheep should

three turnings of passable the  
dry hay being on coasts  
which bring on inflammation I lost  
my own. In consequence of the cattle  
not being well watered the first  
3 days I was so in the first day other  
with a cold and sore throat the sheep  
George was sea sick the whole  
day over the doctor gave no assistance  
in watering or feeding. The stacks  
we were a great deal too much  
crowded the decks were lumbered  
up with hay so that there was  
no doing anything -

now at home. I wish you could  
send me a horse it being what to  
do for to

walk I also want my cloths

Town My sheep are the finest  
in the Colony we have just  
and this morning received news that  
400 head of cattle have arrived  
from New South Wales by land  
The Company have 300 head ~~at~~  
Adelaide is ~~now~~ making  
quite a show brick houses  
are building with hove to all  
at home in haste
