

Portland Nov-15th 1849

My Dear Father

I wrote you by Mr Bruce & Shanks
on the 10th Nov-I have been obliged to dismount
bills for £550 - written by Ed and
Mr Mcintyre as I want money to pay
off the others -I want you to get Brown & Co
either to send me £500 as -
further advance or write to the
Manager of the Union Bank Portland
stating that they wish honor my
drafts on them at 50 days -
for that amount -If you can let Mr Bruce & Shanks
know that the Lawsons has

arrived in London and that
some of her wools were sold -
to be said not effect a higher
price -

I shall be getting wool down
next month - the packs
are larger this year than
they have been for some years -
we have no vessels in Fowland
yet but one embarked every
day 4 with load for London -
and perhaps more it is early in
the season - I start to morning
for the station -
