My Dear Father

I am now in Adelaide
knowing had a disputed boundary
to settle this is two cases I have
had within the last 5 months
and 1000 miles have been ridden
about them and I have gained
my object in both cases and
as you wish he released from
any estate you incurred in getting
me the money last year I should
feel obliged by your sending an
order to Mr. Gibbs to give me up the
Security I gave you which now
stands on the Register and
as I may be in Adelaide or near
it for a few months I shall

be able to get it by your writing
a first note - you could
send under cover to Mr Gikes
through Ed at Lake Leake ^{in Victoria}
I got the £1200 I wanted, at
rather a high interest
I hope the Wool has been
forwarded to Brown & Co at
Aght. There was 108 614 4 nett
washed wool 345 bales. -
we stake here about the
same quantity next year -
I find Adelaide a disagreeable
place - filthy and unhealthy at this season
I am thinking of sailing off in
a few years - and leaving South
Australia -

I was obliged to send the Bank of
Leamy with the drafts as the Bank
would ~~not~~ not discount the Bills

without the Bills of Lading -
The Olden Get the Horse Stearn about
business -

at my last Muster I found we
have \$15,000 Sheep
1500 Cattle
100 Horses

I do not intend putting up any
expensive improvements in at
any time -

You would send letter of March
your kind love to all at Dept
knowing you are all in good
health - I do mean you
and wife too
