May 19 1867

My Dear Father -

It gives me great pleasure  
in receiving your letter of  
May 5<sup>th</sup> - previous to it I had  
not you were much worse  
I do not mean to attend  
local any long - our hospital  
should be annexed to Boston  
it is cut off from Atelvide -  
we must do something beyond  
attending to ourselves  
I must - by I am in Atelvide  
at a great sacrifice  
to my comfort - purse and  
domestic engagement -

My Brothers on Okeh have  
a good inheritance as they  
want is some land which  
they wish have a chance  
of buying - though some  
might have come with  
by ~~coming~~ going to Okech  
Then our work growers here  
that have 1700 bales this  
year - and set for ship  
by the 1000 - but they  
have had to throw in a  
great deal of  
mental and body exertions  
almost breaking the system  
down -  
I got 80 of bale for 160 bales  
and old but much -

This word <sup>was</sup> used since in 1655 -  
it had not - with the help going to  
London -  
with love to my Brothers and  
Sister -
