

Murumbidgee, June 28th 1846

My Dear Father -

I have received to day
the original letter wherein you say
you are trying to get us the
money for 7 1/2 per cent. £2500 -
which I hope you will send and will
it to the Bank of Australasia
Australia - -

I have sent 4000 feet of
and to get nothing to Australia
I expect to get off here the sheep
money - for the cattle - these
I shall not carry -
the sheep -

and I take the rest of on the
wool that has you home 100000
I only got to the amount - to I hope to
have half the money to receive -
the stock on the stations are
as follows - that is two and mine

- 30 000 sheep -
- 1234 - branded cattle
- 40 - branded horses -
- 640 acres of land -

with the large sums available at least
of earning half as much more stock
I consider sheep here are worth 10/-
and cattle £2 including skins - &c -
The stock taken care by a good
Bureau and Lads by themselves
can work with the change they are
very cheap and the sheep will
you can hold the whole of the country

for money you lend. it is madness
to try to borrow in Adelaide they won't.
Lafayette through Utkuskoj say they can
get me the money from Sydney at
10 p cent. and 2% commission —

If you get it me for 7% it is much
the better —

you will let me know who the
good is to be shipped to, about —

100000 D. I'm worth — of course —
it will make more than cover the
money I am borrowing — ^{the wool} at 11 —

If we cannot get it for wool it is a
wonder growing —
