# Proposed Amendments To the Draft of A Bill To constitute The Commonwealth of Australia

1. In section 48 strike out subsection 2.

This sub-section would prevent any Barrister,  
who is a member of the Federal Parliament,  
being appointed ~~as~~ a Judge of the High Court,  
and would, therefore, limit the area of selection  
for judges of that court  
~~A~~ ~~Judges from the members of the Bar~~, and  
might frequently prevent the appointment of the  
man most fitted to fill an immediate vacancy.

It would, also, prevent the appointment of any  
Member of the Federal Parliament to the position

of Agent General to the Commonwealth in London.

In regard to other places of profit, the question whether or not members of the Federal Parliament should be

eligible for them, is one that ~~it would be more proper~~,  
~~it is more desirable to leave~~  
~~left to the decision of the Federal Parliament, than to~~  
~~to settle~~  
~~be ~~left out~~ in the Constitution.~~

(9) In Section 52, lines 2 and 3, strike out "for the peace, order, and good Government of the Commonwealth"

These words are copied from the several Acts of the Imperial Parliament providing

for the establishment of Legislatures in the various

Australian Colonies, and are perfectly appropriate when used in reference to the establishment of a Legislature
