1 Degree of Associate of Arts 22 Sept. 1863

Diploma of degree of Associate of Arts awarded to Henry Lewis Garrett of Hobart Town, who passed in English, Latin (with credit and prize), Greek, French (with credit) and pure mathematics and was placed in the second class. Signed by "Officer, president of Tasmanian Council of Education. Seal of Tasmanian Council of Education 1859, red wax, lozenge shaped, backed paper: open book 'Floreat Tasmania' on diamond pattern, in tin (separate from document). Diploma has decorative border of oak leaves and acorns designed by Henry Hunter and engraved by Alfred Bock.
