MOLESWORTH JEFFERY

Rev. Molesworth Jeffery, Anglican clergyman, of Bournbank, Lachlan, died on 24 March 1900 aged 89. He had several children, including Rufus de Bournbank who died on 23 August 1892, aged 49.

1-4 Letters to his sisters 1869 - 1892

Letters from Molesworth Jeffery to his sisters Susanna and Catherine (Kate) in U.K. - mentions the drought in 1869, 'terrible winter' of 1872, general election 1872 'the first since the free constitution', Thomas Irvine photographing St. George's Chapel, Lachlan, in 1892; also weather, snakes, fruit, jam, family affairs, etc.
