

DESCRIPTION OF A SPECIES OF SEA BREAM  
(*GIRELLA TRICUSPIDATA*), FROM SOUTHPORT,  
TASMANIA.

D  $\frac{15}{8}$ , A  $\frac{3}{12}$ , L. lat. 54-56, L. tr.  $\frac{11}{8}$ . The length of head is one fifth of the total length. Dorsal fin of moderate height, the spinous portion lower than the soft. The incisors three-pointed, moderately broad, imbricate, in several series in the upper and lower jaws. Colour uniform blackish-brown, with lighter tinge of olive towards belly and lower portion of head.
