My dear Jane,

We are requested to remain here till Friday May when it is our intention to start on our return home. I wish you would send a horse to Oakland on Friday evening to help us along. We had a pleasant journey over we reached ^{arranging} the day we left home at ^{the} port of call and the next day arrived at ^{the} destination. My left leg suffered a good deal from the same, & your Mother was a little fatigued which is all the inconvenience we experienced on the road.

Your Mother wishes you would
on Saturday Morn. give to
