tho' it ops into the bladder - & drew out the

Had procured another silver
Catheter he succeed in introd. it
along the urethra into the bladder
& kept it there for 4 days
w^{ch} the Penis swelled considerably
& the Catheter was withdrawn it is
on the subsidence of the swells of
the Penis the Catheter was again
attempted but did not succeed
&

he was very sick & faint dur'd the day
with feces & urine were mixed with blood.
In the night dysuria continued with
severe pain of the testis the Med. Attend^r
arr'd in the Morn^g & attempt to pass
a silver Catheter. w^{ch} however broken he
the open of perineum ^{about an inch from the top of} anterior to the
strips. the urine flowed thro' this ops
& the piece of Catheter was introd. to enter
the bladder to keep it open
