My dear Sir

I have herewith sent a statement as new as I can – of my debts and assets – which I think will show – that if I have friends to help me – I may recover myself in one or two years without any loss to them in any way except the inconvenience of waiting – The assets I would give over, tho perhaps overrated are not I hope very greatly so –
