 life without impeachment of waste and from and after his  
 decease to Eliza Cotton Daughter of the said Thomas  
 Cotton and her heirs And I give devise and  
 bequeath the residue of my real and all my personal  
 Estate to the said Edward Octavius Cotton his heirs  
 executors and administrators In Witness whereof  
 my name has been set hereto this \_\_\_\_\_ day  
 of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
 hundred and eighty three

We the undersigned hereby attest the execution  
 of the foregoing writing by James Cotton  
 as the last Will and Testament of George  
 Fordyce Story of Kelvedon Great Swanport in  
 Tasmania Doctor of Medicine by signing his

 said George Fordyce Story declared the same to be his  
 last Will.
