at the 1st Annual Meet^g
held 7th Mo 1819 -

To the Person's Professing with the Society of Friends in South
Australia and others whom this may concern.

At a Yearly Meeting of the Society of Friends in Van
Diemen's Land, held at Hobart Town, on the 8th and by
adjournments to the 15th of 12th Month 1848.

George Fordyce Story, a member of Launceston Monthly
Meeting, and a Minister in good esteem amongst us, having laid before this
meeting a concern to proceed to South Australia in the love of the Gospel, and
there to visit the Families of Friends, and attend to such other religious duties
as may be required of him. The subject has had our solid consideration,
and feeling unity with him therein, we hereby liberate him for this important service.

We fervently desire that the Great Head of the Church, who, we
believe, has called forth our dear friend to labour in that portion of His arneyard,
may go with him and favour him from day to day with the discoveries of
His Holy Will, and strengthen him by His grace to fulfil all that
may be called for at his hands.

Commending this our dear friend to the sympathy
and kind notice of those amongst whom his lot may be cast; we
earnestly crave that his labours among them, may be blessed to their
comfort and edification, — to the extension of the Redeemer's kingdom
and to his own peace.
