Dominic Redfern is a Melbourne based artist, active in all aspects of video art culture in Australia. His work utilises a range of performative video art practices and is characterised by a self-deprecating humour, an air of threat and a playfully self-reflexive frame of reference.

Dominic will speak on his use of performance in his video practice and his current shift from private and personal backdrops into the landscape. He will discuss his forthcoming solo show at CAMAC in rural France, which will involve a performance work shot in Tasmania's Queentown, as well as his 2007 show at Thailand's Chulalongkorn Art Centre which brought together Victoria's largest salt lake and Bangkok's hectic weekend market.
