Daniel von Sturmer



Daniel von Sturmer was born in Auckland, New Zealand in 1972 and has resided in Melbourne since 1992. He was awarded an MA from RMIT University in 1999 and received a Samstag scholarship for further studies in the Netherlands in 2002. He has shown widely in Australia and internationally, and in 2007 was one of 3 artists chosen to represent Australia at the Venice Biennale.

Daniel will discuss his art practice focusing on particular works from the last few years. He will examine ideas in the work such as the role of the viewer, the experience of time, and how context shapes the apprehension of an artwork.
