the said *Robert*

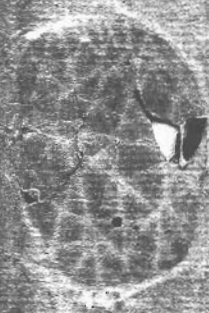
will cause an appearance to be entered for you, and will proceed thereon, as if you had
